pro justice ethics from lament to nonviolence is an original work within christian social ethics and is based upon the civil rights movement the philosophy of nonviolence and the biblical lament tradition the author formulates the justice imperative as an ethic of duty and defines justice as an act of protesting preventing and remedying injustices that cause human suffering formally injustice is the violation of fairness equality and dignity but in its primal form injustice is child abuse birth and death are discussed from a justice perspective beyond the dichotomy of pro life and pro choice special attention is devoted to the injustices of globalization international human rights abuses and corporate violations of the natural rights of water in the earth commons book jacket

presents a beautiful vision of how we could change our structures and order to give us a new role on earth one that will protect the natural world rather than destroy it we are rapidly destroying our only habitat earth it is becoming clear that many of the treaties laws and policies concluded in recent years have failed to slow down let alone halt or reverse this process the concept of introducing a wild law has been seminal in informing and inspiring the global movement to recognise rights for nature a movement destined to shape the twenty first century as significantly as the human rights movements shaped the twentieth century written by environmental attorney cormac cullinan wild law outlines an earth centred approach to re ordering human societies earth jurisprudence it is a manifest on how we can conserve biological and cultural diversity animal rights and welfare and green spirituality by rediscovering a role for our species within the earth community after all we have no future without our wonderful planet fusing together politics legal theory quantum physics and ancient wisdom into a fascinating and hopeful story wild law reveals how the governance systems of today legitimise and promote the disastrous exploitation and destruction of earth cormac explains how to begin transforming our systems to ensure that the pursuit of human well being enhances the beauty health and diversity of earth instead of diminishing it wild law is an inspiring and stimulating book for anyone who cares about earth and is concerned about the direction in which the human species is moving

food in a just world examines the violence social breakdown and environmental consequences of our global system of food production distribution and consumption where each step of the process is built on some form of exploitation while highlighting the broken system s continuities from european colonialism the authors argue that the seeds of resilience resistance and inclusive cultural resurgence are already being reflected in the day to day actions of communities around the world calling for urgent change the book looks at how genuine democracy would give individuals and communities meaningful control over the decisions that impact their lives when seeking to secure humanely this most basic human need drawing on the perspectives of advocates activists workers researchers and policymakers harris and gibbs explore the politics of food in the context of capitalist globalization and the climate crisis uncovering the complexities in our relationships with one another with other animals and with the natural world

purveyors of genetically modified organisms gmos relentlessly researched environmental movements of india chipko narmada bachao andolan navdanya presents these movements in a framework that explores hindu vedic wisdom as well as development ethics global environment ethics feminist care ethics and the capability approach at a moment when the climate threatens populations who live closest to nature and depend upon its fodder for heat its water for life and its seeds for food mallick shows how nonviolent action can give poor people an effective voice

covers the various aspects of war in the twenty first century where asymmetric warfare has changed many rules of the game imposing a profound transformation on the military not only tactical but also structural preparatory mental and ideological this book also covers the delicate relations between the armed forces and societies

the book covers lung colorectal breast prostate and virally caused cancers it interweaves conventional medical knowledge of these cancers with modern realities of everyday life we all live and with chinese medicine interpretations and strategies for treating probable pre cancerous conditions
