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if we want to decolonize the history of art argues kristopher kersey we must rethink our
approach to the historical record this means dispensing with eurocentric binaries
divisions between western and non western modern and premodern and making a

commitment to artworks that challenge the perspectives we build upon them in facing images the question takes elegant and intriguing form if the aesthetic hallmarks of modernity can be found in twelfth century art what does it really mean to be modern kersey s answer to this question models a new historiography facing images begins by tracing the turbulent discourse surrounding the emergence of japanese art history as a modern field in lieu of examining canonical works from the twelfth century kersey foregrounds the elusive and the enigmatic in artworks little known and understudied outside japan the manuscripts he selects defy traditional art historical narratives by exhibiting decidedly modern techniques including montage self reference reuse noise dissonance and chronological disarray kersey weaves these medieval case studies together with insights from a wide range of interdisciplinary scholarship using a methodology that will prove important for historians facing images produces a history of non western art in which diverse and anachronic works are brought responsibly and equitably into dialogue with the present without being subsumed under eurocentric formalisms or false universals a timely intervention in the history of medieval japanese art art historiography and the history of global modernism facing images redefines the relationship of the premodern non west to modern art it will be of particular interest to scholars of medieval japanese art and of modernism

an aphorism sutra expresses the genus of its meaning in a few terse words the brahma sutras systemati cally explain the basic principles of vedanta the science of supreme reality when contemplated they reveal the innermost metaphysical secrets today harmony is the need of the hour the ephemeral world needs spiritual awareness and this is what the vedantins visualise vedic scriptures offer comforting counsel they throw a kindly light man has distorted vision he dotes on apparently real and also non real

phenomena true vision makes him cognize the universal being in nature's creations realization of this awareness is liberation moksha the be all and end all of life of the human being is the realization of constant integrated awareness of brahman visualized both as the primary absolute supreme unlimited entity and as its subsidiary cosmic creative aspect and mergence in brahman in this stream of aphorisms sutra vahini on brahman bhagavan sri sathya sai baba has lighted the universal lamp of the wisdom of atma brahman divine self this stream of aphorisms first appeared in serialized form in sanathana sarathi bhagavan in his infinite love elaborated on the essence of brahma sutras in twelve selected aphorisms bhagavan's sublime and profound words and spiritual wisdom are indeed highly elevating and illuminating bathing in this pellucid stream of aphorisms a person develops correct or true vision of reality bestowing supreme delight in the words of bhagavan baba acquisition of the higher knowledge alone can fulfill the main purpose of human life such knowledge makes one aware that one is not the inert insentient body etc but that one is consciousness itself manifesting as the embodiment of being awareness bliss satchidananda when this truth dawns and is experienced one becomes a person liberated while alive this is the state of realization of the innate nature of a people the divinity of humanity

following the shambhala sutra an ancient manuscript written by penchen lama over two hundred years ago laurence brahm started his journey to shambhala in lhasa and continued deep into the harsh regions of tibet shambhala sutra presents brahm's expedition across western tibet's ngari region where he learned that the ancient sutra was actually a metaphorical guidebook he traces a route embedded with riddles through deserts and mountains the lessons learned from this journey as told in the sutra as a prophecy are that shortsighted greed war and failure to protect our environment will cause kingdoms and empires to vanish mankind's future depends on ensuring a sustainable planet through more holistic economics empowering communities and people and preserving our environment these are the messages hidden in the shambhala sutra

beginning with the claim that the popularization of buddhism in the medieval period was a phenomenon of visual culture explaining pictures reexamines the history and historiography of medieval japanese buddhism with theoretical sophistication and a full

appreciation of the power of imagery to convey and control religious meaning it investigates a range of aspects of etoki including the particularly active role of itinerant nuns whose performances were especially edifying to female audiences as well as the visual hagiography of the reputed founder of japanese buddhism the pictorial projections of buddhist paradise and hell and the explanation through visual imagery of sacred mountains explaining pictures is the first book length study in english devoted to the phenomenon of buddhist art as religious propaganda and pictorial storytelling as a form of popular culture in medieval japan a truly interdisciplinary study it suggests fruitful avenues of discussion between art historians and historians of japanese buddhism scholars and students with an interest in japanese buddhism art and social and cultural history will find its examination of significant issues fresh and stimulating it will also find an appreciative audience among those concerned with the relationship between art and religion the mechanics of proselytization and asian visual culture

in literature for little bodhisattvas natasha heller makes two key interventions first she argues that picturebooks are a new genre of buddhist writing and second she calls attention to an emergent family buddhism in taiwan that fashions children as religious subjects through shared attention with adult readers surveying taiwanese buddhism from the ground up heller explores the changing family dynamics that have made children into a crucial audience for buddhist education and the home a key site for buddhist cultivation by taking picturebooks seriously as part of the buddhist textual tradition heller demonstrates their engagement with canonical sources alongside innovations for modern audiences close readings analyzing both text and image trace

narrative themes about buddhist figures and connect representations of buddhas and bodhisattvas to a visual culture where new values such as cuteness are articulated heller shows that picturebooks have become an integral part of a contemporary buddhist education that equips children with strategies to interpret everyday life in buddhist ways and provides religious models for action in the modern world literature for little bodhisattvas is a pathbreaking work revealing how contemporary picturebooks reframe buddhism and offer fresh perspectives on its teachings and ideals of family for both children and adults

buddhists around the world celebrate the benefits of worshipping kannon avalokiteśvara a compassionate savior who is one of the most beloved in the buddhist pantheon when kannon appears in multiple manifestations the deity s powers are believed to increase to even greater heights this concept generated several cults throughout history among the most significant is the cult of the six kannon which began in japan in the tenth century and remained prominent through the sixteenth century in this ambitious work sherry fowler examines the development of the japanese six kannon cult its sculptures and paintings and its transition to the thirty three kannon cult which remains active to this day an exemplar of six kannon imagery is the complete set of life size wooden sculptures made in 1224 and housed at the kyoto temple daihōonji this set along with others is analyzed to demonstrate how six kannon worship impacted buddhist practice employing a diachronic approach fowler presents case studies beginning in the eleventh century to reinstate a context for sets of six kannon the majority of which have been lost or scattered and thus illuminates the vibrancy magnitude and distribution of the cult and enhances our knowledge of religious image making in japan kannon s role in assisting beings trapped in the six paths of transmigration is a well documented catalyst for the selection of the number six but there are other significant themes at work six kannon worship includes significant foci on worldly concerns such as childbirth and animal husbandry ties between text and image and numerous correlations with shinto kami groups of six while making groups of kannon visible fowler explores the fluidity of numerical deity categorizations and the attempts to quantify the invisible moreover her investigation reveals kyushu as an

especially active site in the history of the six kannon cult much as kannon images once functioned to attract worshippers their presentation in this book will entice contemporary readers to revisit their assumptions about east asia s most popular buddhist deity

the yoga sutras of patanjali are in themselves exceedingly brief less than ten pages of large type in the original yet they contain the essence of practical wisdom set forth in admirable order and detail the theme if the present interpreter be right is the great regeneration the birth of the spiritual from the psychical man the same theme which paul so wisely and eloquently set forth in writing to his disciples in corinth the theme of all mystics in all lands

in considering medieval illustrated buddhist manuscripts as sacred objects of cultic innovation receptacle of the sacred explores how and why the south asian buddhist book cult has survived for almost two millennia to the present a book manuscript should be understood as a form of sacred space a temple in microcosm not only imbued with divine presence but also layered with the memories of many generations of users jinah kim argues that illustrating a manuscript with buddhist imagery not only empowered it as a three dimensional sacred object but also made it a suitable tool for the spiritual transformation of medieval indian practitioners through a detailed historical analysis of sanskrit colophons on patronage production and use of illustrated manuscripts she suggests that while buddhism s disappearance in eastern india was a slow and gradual process the buddhist book cult played an important role in sustaining its identity in addition by examining the physical traces left by later nepalese users and the contemporary ritual use of the book in nepal kim shows how human agency was critical in perpetuating and intensifying the potency of a manuscript as a sacred object throughout time

imagine a world without principia mathematica rights of man the bible shakespeare or the mahabharata books that changed history features 75 of the world s most momentous titles from the art of war to anne frank s diary and reveals their far ranging impact books are the medium through which scientists storytellers and philosophers introduce their ideas discover seminal religious and political titles cornerstones of

science such as on the origin of species and ancient texts such as the i ching which is still used today to answer fundamental questions about human existence get up close to see fascinating details such as versalius exquisite anatomical illustrations in epitome leonardo da vinci s annotated notebooks or the hand decorated pages in the gutenber bible discover why euclid s elements of geometry was the most influential maths title ever published and marvel at rare treasures such as the aubin codex which tells the history of the aztecs and the early spanaish colonial period in mexico books that changed history gathers stories diaries scientific treatises plays dictionaries and religious texts into a stunning celebration of the power of books

this is the first scholarly treatment of the emergence of american buddhist studies as a significant research field until now few investigators have turned their attention to the interpretive challenge posed by the presence of all the traditional lineages of asian buddhism in a consciously multicultural society nor have scholars considered the place of their own contributions as writers teachers and practising buddhists in this unfolding saga in thirteen chapters and a critical introduction to the field the book treats issues such as asian american buddhist identity the new buddhism buddhism and american culture and the scholar s place in american buddhist studies the volume offers complete lists of dissertations and theses on american buddhism and north american dissertations and theses on topics related to buddhism since 1892
